On behalf of Riverside Presbyterian, it is my pleasure to welcome you to worship this morning. The opportunity to worship together as the Family is one of God’s great gifts.

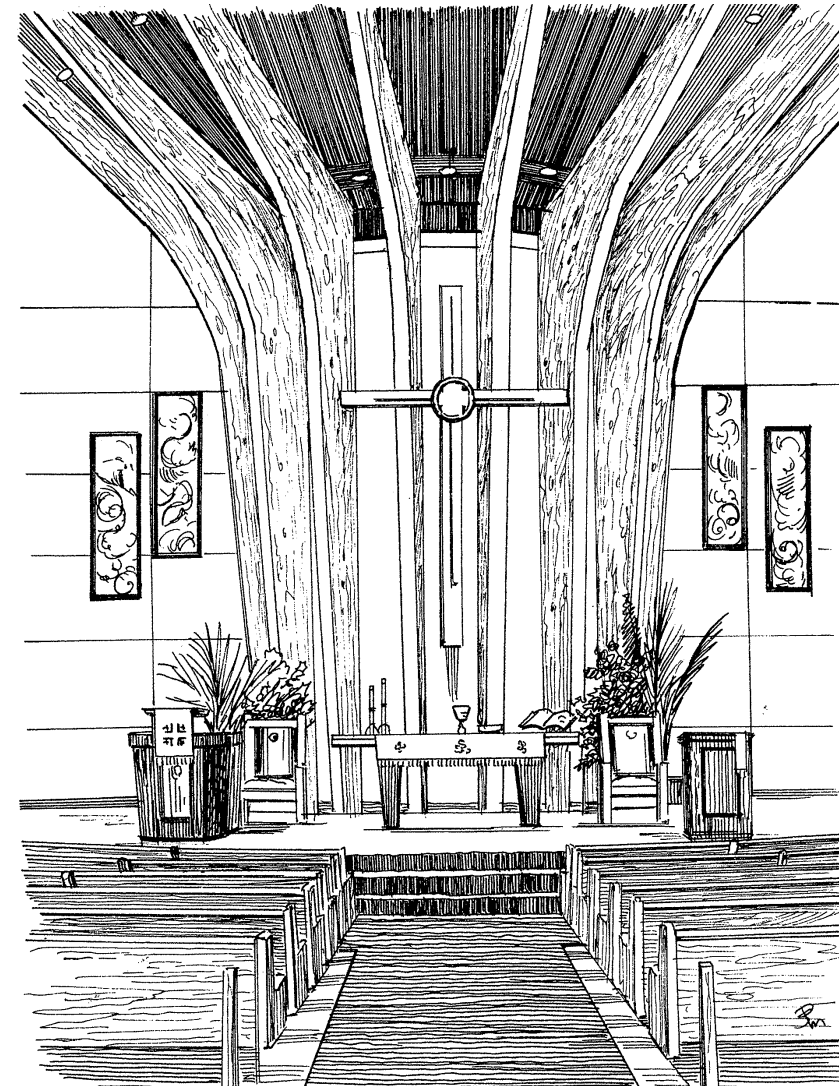
It is my hope that this time and place will be a grounding place for us all, one that enables us to live as freely and fully as God intends.
