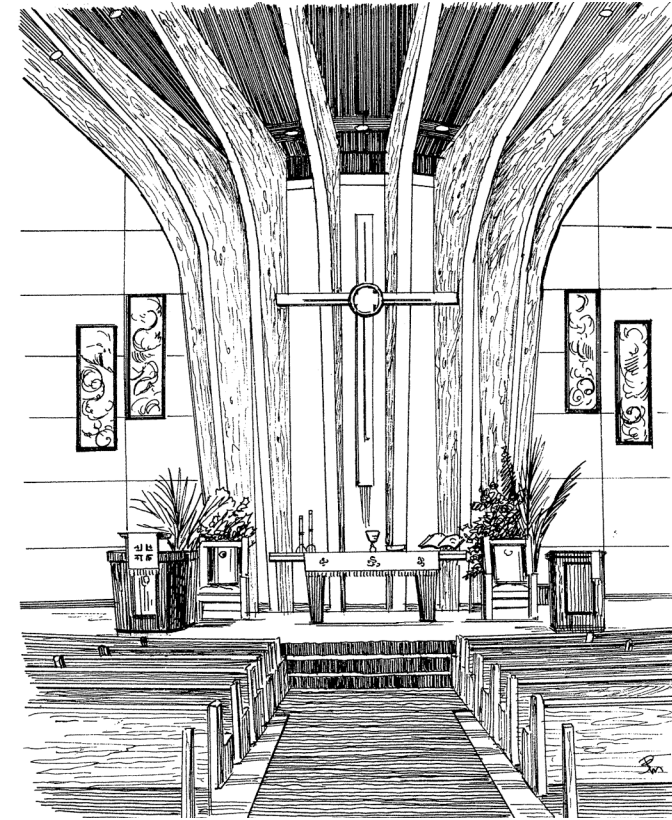
ANNOUNCEMENTS
